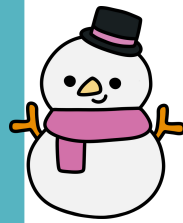




Q: What do snowmen wear on their heads?

A: In a snow bank.



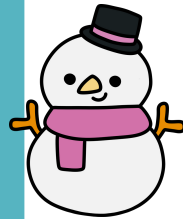
Q: How does a Snowman get to work?

A: Ask the dog.



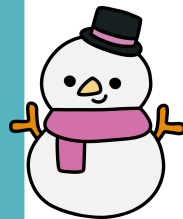
Q: What did the police officer say when he saw the snowman stealing?

A: Brrrr – itos.

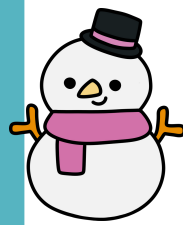


Q: What did the snowman order at Wendy's?
A: A Frosty.



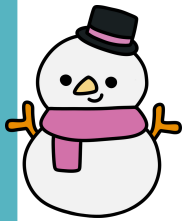
Q: What do snowmen do on Christmas?

A: Chill-dren.



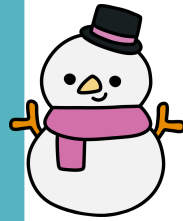
Q: What do you call a melted snowman?

A: Freeze a jolly good fellow!



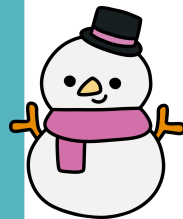
Q: Who is Frosty's favorite Aunt?

A: Aunt Arctica.



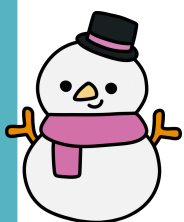
Q: What do you call a snowman's holiday party?
